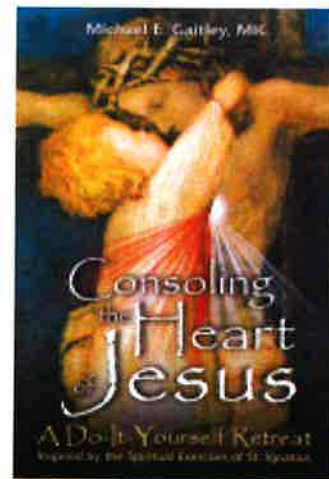


If you wish to join the Bible Study, you must contact Mary Rak at marycarterrak87@gmail.com by Feb 1.


