

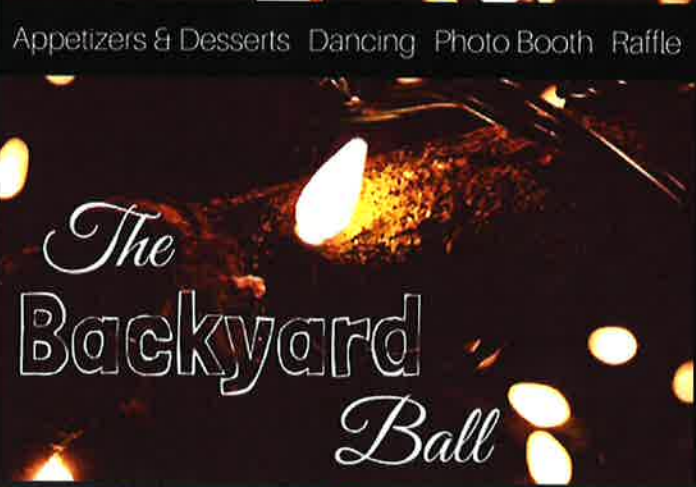

Seven Lively Virtues
STUDY PROGRAM



Grow in holiness this Lent by learning practical ways to combat the seven deadly sins. For students only.

An explanation of FASTING and ABSTINENCE

WHAT:

Fasting – Fasting is a reduction of the amount of food eaten.

Abstinence – Abstinence is not eating a specific food or type of food.

WHEN:

Fasting – Fasting from all food and drink is required for a period of one hour before receiving Holy Communion. It is permitted to drink water and to take medications during this hour.

Fasting is required on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. When fasting for a day, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal.

Abstinence – Abstaining from meat is required on Ash Wednesday and all Fridays in Lent.

WHO:

Fasting – Fasting is required for all people from age 18 to 59. People who are nursing, have medical limitations, or whose work includes heavy labor are not required to fast.

Abstinence – Abstinence is required for all persons over age 18. People who are nursing, have medical limitations, or whose work includes heavy labor are not required to abstain from meat during Lent.
