Letter from our UNT Campus Minister

Peace be with you!

I wanted to thank all of you for supporting our campus ministry with your prayers and donations. We had a great year last year! We saw a 25% increase in the average attendance of our Thursday student community night and saw a strong commitment to prayer among the students. To name a few areas of growth for the upcoming year, we are adding two new catechetical classes in addition to our Theology of the Body class- The Communion of Faith and Reason (a blend of apologetics and catechesis) and Didache: The Catholic Faith Explained, a more basic catechetical class. We are also starting a weekly Men's Ministry called St. Joseph's Workshop led by Fr. Kyle and a monthly Women's Ministry group to help build a culture of authentic sisterhood and explore the feminine genius. We may also have the beginnings of a consistent works of mercy group. It's all very exciting! As we expand our ministry, we are able to offer a holistic way of life to the students in which one becomes solidly rooted in Christ and led by the Holy Spirit in daily life so as to be formed into saints.

We need help to accomplish this! One need UNT Catholic Campus Ministry still has this semester is for meal providers for Thursday Night's Mass & Meal. There is a deepening of relationship and community when a group can share a meal together, just as our deepest communion with Christ is through a meal. As we seek to feed the students physically, we pray that it opens their hearts to also be nourished spiritually by Christ.

We are expecting an average of about 80 students on Thursday nights, with possible growth to 90+ this year. I ask that a meal consist of a protein, a starch, a vegetable, and a fruit or dessert. JPII can provide the plates, utensils, and drinks.

Hospitality Helpers Needed!


